

Coming as a Group? Make the Most of Your Experience by Following These Tips:

- One day prior to your visit, please remind your group to dress accordingly for an outdoor experience. Make sure children wear footwear suitable for walking outdoors and in the Gardens. Closed-toed shoes are recommended. (The Gardens and Market may be muddy after rainfall.)
- To maximize the experience, it helps to break larger groups into small groups of green thumbs. The small groups should have three-four people and chaperones for school-aged children. Smaller groups are encouraged for more personal attention and gardening time.
- If you are bringing kids, designate at least one chaperone for each group of rotating students. The chaperone can be a teacher, parent or volunteer. Below is a sample schedule and breakdown that demonstrates a successful system for breaking up a large group. The sample class list/schedule below included enough parent chaperones to provide two per group. Please try to create a similar list for your group.
